A bold architectural statement

Introducing the Pleat Mirror by Swedish Gustav Winsth for Muuto, designed in Stockholm and crafted in Denmark. A mirror that reimagines a full-length mirror as a sculptural, architectural element. Made from mirror-polished stainless steel, it reflects its surroundings with a bold, contemporary expression, while its folded form adds depth and visual interest. The reflective surface shifts with the room and light, behaving almost like a living artwork.

Cut from a single steel sheet to precise proportions, its scale echoes a doorway, lending it presence in both residential and commercial spaces. Combining industrial materiality with soft, fluid curves, Pleat Mirror feels minimal yet commanding.

Gustav Winsth runs his Stockholm-based studio with a curious eye on process. With a background in mechanical engineering, his work often begins with method – exploring how manufacturing techniques and materials can inform form. The result is a design language that feels equal parts industrial and expressive. Always looking for new ways to shape and connect, Winsth brings a technical elegance to objects that invite both use and inspection.
